Pt admitted via A+E for perforation of oesophagus post gastric banding 4 days earlier. CXR showed air fluid level beneath the right hemi diaphragm. CT abdo+pelvis showed 3 fluid collections. Laparoscopy performed. Fluid aspirated. Banding device removed. Fundoplication sutures removed. Drains inserted. Pt had pyrexia a few days post op and chest infection, CT abdo repeated. Small fluid collection. Pt recovered fully. For follow up in Prof Conlon's OPD in 4-6 week
